

# **CAMPFIRE RULES & REGULATIONS**



1. Fire drums can be hired at reception during office hours only 8:30am – 5:30pm.
2. Due to our council permit NO BYO campfires, only campfires supplied by PCCP are permitted.
3. We will deliver the fire drum and fire wood to your site along with a bucket for water.
4. Fire wood can be purchased from reception during office hours only 8:30am – 5:30pm. If you supply your own wood, please make sure it is dry & split.
5. On departure we will collect fire drums and ashes from your site. Please do not empty ash or burning embers onto grass.
6. Campfires are not allowed during a total fire ban; we will notify guests when this has been declared.
7. Campfires are not permitted during extreme weather conditions or at Managers discretion.
8. Please be mindful of where you place your fire drum- be aware of your neighbours, natural surroundings, branches and awnings.
9. A bucket for water will be provided with your fire pit and has to be filled with water and placed within 1 metre of the fire drum.
10. Fires cannot be left unattended at any time.
11. Children must not be left unattended at any time.
12. A responsible adult must be in attendance at all times and assume all levels of responsibility and liability to their own property, neighbouring sites and to the property of Pine Country Caravan Park.
13. All fires to be extinguished before going to bed. Last logs on at 10pm – fire to be extinguished by 11pm.
14. Please be respectful of your neighbour – they may not enjoy smoke.
15. Please do not burn rubbish or food scraps.

**Park Management reserves the right to collect fire pit without warning if above rules are not adhered to.**
