



DOG FRIENDLY CABIN

At Pine Country Caravan Park, we love that we are able to provide pet friendly accommodation!

However, we do have some simple, respectful rules that do apply!

Kindly make yourself familiar with the Dog Policy Agreement outlined below:

DOG POLICY AGREEMENT – DOG CABIN

1. The dedicated dog cabin is for well behaved, house trained dogs only.
2. Dogs are welcome to enjoy inside the cabin, however are NOT permitted on any cabin furniture.
3. Dog bed or dog bedding is NOT provided, we advise that you bring your own dogs bed from home, this will also help make your pet feel more comfortable in an unfamiliar space.
4. A dog water bowl is provided within the cabin.
5. Maximum of two dogs permitted.
6. Please clean up any spills or accidents immediately inside the cabin, general cleaning products are supplied.
7. Please leave the cabin in a clean and tidy condition as you found it.
8. Please ensure all your dog's waste is collected from the cabin yard.
9. We ask that you prevent your dog from digging holes.
10. Dogs must be supervised at all times and **never left unattended**, including inside or outside the cabin.
11. When dogs are not within the fenced cabin yard they must be on a leash at **ALL** times.
12. For health and Safety reasons, dogs are not allowed in any common areas of the park, including camp kitchen, BBQ area, amenities block, playground, reception or any public/communal areas.
13. Dog owners are 100% responsible for picking up and disposing of their dog's waste in a **sealed** plastic bag and disposed of in rubbish bins.
14. For health and safety reasons dogs must not be washed or cleaned anywhere within the park, additionally any dog related accessories such as dog blankets/bedding should not be washed or cleaned within the park laundry facilities.
15. Dog owners are personally responsible and will be held to be so, for any and all personal injuries and/ or property damage or losses in relation to any actions caused by or because of their dog.
16. It is the dog owner's sole responsibility to control and manage their dog at all times. If in the view of Park Management this has not happened to an acceptable level, the owner and the dog may be evicted from the park immediately.
17. The dog owner must agree that the Park Manager reserves the right to evict any guests whose dog is deemed noisy, disruptive and aggressive or the subject of a complaint/s from other guests.
