



We are fortunate enough to have been granted a special council permit so our guests can enjoy camp fires all year round. We consider this a privilege! Our park neighbours farm land, we take these rules & regulations extremely seriously!

CAMPFIRE RULES & REGULATIONS

Please ensure to **READ** carefully and tick each point.

1. Due to our council permit NO BYO campfires are allowed, only campfires supplied by Pine Country Caravan Park are permitted.
2. Please do not empty ash or burning embers onto grass.
3. Campfires are strictly not allowed during a **total fire ban**; staff will notify guests when this has been declared.
4. Campfires are not permitted during extreme weather conditions or at Managers discretion.
5. Please be mindful of where you place your fire drum- be aware of natural surroundings, low hanging branches and awnings. Please be respectful of your neighbour – they may not enjoy smoke.
6. A bucket of water will be provided with your fire pit and must be filled with water and placed within 1 metre of the fire drum.
7. Fires cannot be left unattended at any time - Children must not be left unattended at any time while the fire drum is in use.
8. A responsible adult must be in attendance at all times and assume all levels of responsibility and liability to their own property, neighbouring sites and to the property of Pine Country Caravan Park.
9. If you supply your own wood, please make sure it is dry & split.
10. Please do not burn rubbish or food scraps.
11. **All fires to be extinguished completely (including coals) before going to bed.**
Last logs on at 10pm – fire to be extinguished by 11pm.

Additional Fire wood and kindling can be purchased from reception between 8:30am – 5:30pm

Park Management reserve the right to collect fire pit without warning if above rules are not adhered to. No refunds will be given!



FIRE PIT HIRE TERMS & CONDITIONS

The guest agrees to be solely responsible for any and all acts of safety and behaviour while the fire pit is in use.
